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Bill Title: Relating to mental health treatment providers.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Cities, Department of Consumer and Business Services, Counties, Oregon Health Authority

Summary of Fiscal Impact

Measure Description

The measure adds licensed outpatient facilities that employ certified alcohol and drug counselors to the definition of "provider" which permits these facilities to be covered by insurance for mental health treatment.

Fiscal Analysis

Oregon Health Authority

The Public Employees' Benefit Board (PEBB), budgeted within the Oregon Health Authority, anticipates an unknown increase in costs. The increase is dependent on the utilization of services and the negotiated rate for each contract. The Oregon Educator's Benefit Board (OEBB) indicates the fiscal impact will be minimal.

The measure has no fiscal impact on the Department of Consumer and Business Services, cities, or counties.
