BONDS FOR A BALLPARK

- SB 5, passed in 2003, authorized \$150 million in bonding capacity to help fund the construction of a new MLB ballpark.
- We propose modernization of SB 5 to better reflect current revenue generated by player's salaries and the rising costs of building a world class stadium.
- O Those same players' salaries and all personnel earning over \$50k annually will be taxed to pay off this bond.
- ¹⁰ Once paid off, new tax revenue goes to the general fund.
- \odot This is NOT a new or additional tax.
