

6PPD-quinone Impacts to salmon and trout

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6PPD-quinone is a compound added to tires to prevent degradation



6PPD-q is very toxic to some salmon/trout species

Exposure to 41 ng/L for 24 h kills 50% of coho salmon



20-90%

Observed adult mortality in Puget sound streams

Beginning to document the issue in Oregon

High percentage of coho adults die before spawning in Beaver Creek (Gresham, OR)



*Limited surveys due to Covid



Solutions

- Long term: Develop an alternative chemical for tires
 - In development
 - Likely decades before all 6PPD-q off the roads

Until then: Treatment of 6PPD-q before enters streams

- Extensive ongoing research
- Promising results
- Can greatly reduce 6PPD-q and allow fish survival
