WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure appropriates \$1,023,235 General Fund to the Oregon Department of Human Services (DAS) for distribution to South Coast Business Employment Corporation to provide meals to elderly individuals. The measure takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The <u>South Coast Business Employment Corporation (SCB)</u> is a domestic nonprofit corporation that is one of Oregon's 16 <u>Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs)</u>. AAAs provide services to older adults at the local and regional level. SCB oversees the operation of seven congregate meal sites and provides home delivered meals in Coos and Curry counties. <u>According to SCB</u>, 367 seniors receive meals daily either through the Home Delivered Meals program or through the Congregate Meals Program.
