## **Questions & Answers**

Question: Provide a list of the applicants as well as the successful grantees who received the Summer Learning grants since the beginning of the program.

**Response:** The State Summer Learning Grant (2024) allocations were awarded to eligible entities, including school districts, charter schools, and Education Service Districts, based on priority ranking and available funding. The <u>Summer Learning Allocation List</u> provides a record of awarded grantees and eligible applicants, including total grant amounts. This information is publicly available under the Allocation section on our Summer Learning Grants <u>webpage</u>.

Question: Provide the equalization numbers by school for comparison.

**Response:** The SSF equalization numbers are calculated at the district level, where we account for property taxes, and not at the school level. We post school district SSF estimates, which include the Equalization numbers (also known as the General Purpose Grant), on this <u>website</u> under the section labeled District Estimates.
