Bill Title: Relating to student data; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Education, School Districts, Oregon Youth Authority, Department of Administrative Services, Task Force/Committee/Workgroup

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to develop and implement a standardized method to be used by school districts, education service districts, and ODE to electronically create, collect, use, maintain, disclose, transfer, and access student data from multiple platforms.

Among other things, ODE must establish student data standards, develop a data collection method, ensure that the method reduces or eliminates redundancies related to student data, and establish a schedule to train school districts and education service districts. ODE shall also establish a technical advisory committee to assist in the development and implementation of the data collection method. The advisory committee shall, among other things, oversee the implementation of the method and submit reports to the State Board of Education and interim legislative committees related to education by October 1 of every even-numbered year.

The measure is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on ODE and school districts.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
