

- Governor's Budget Highlights
 - Growing programs strategically, to meet customer demand
 - Funding in EIS to continue lifecycle and security investments
 - Increased risk rates to agencies to improve overall health of fund
 - Targeted reductions to lower increases to rates and assessments


Department of Administrative Services Expenditure History + 2025-27 Governor's Budget



Department of Administrative Services Revenue Sources



- Primary Source of Funding is Rates and Assessments, received through agencies from:
 - General Fund 52.7 percent
 - Lottery Funds 1.1 percent
 - Other Funds 32.0 percent
 - Federal Funds 9.0 percent
- Lottery Funds received for pass-through payments
- General Fund includes pass-through payments, as well as funds for specific packages
- Federal Funds for continued ARPA expenditures and continuation of COVID Fiscal Relief Team

Department of Administrative Services 2025-27 Governor's Budget Packages



- General Fund Investments for:
 - Funding for Innovation Law Lab for Universal Representation
 - EV Statewide Charging Infrastructure Program
 - Wrongful Convictions Funding (for payment to DOJ)
 - Coordinated Data Governance and Infrastructure to support Housing Initiative
- Highlights of investments in programs to support operational needs:
 - Customer requests for services from client agencies
 - Workday reorganization and stabilization
 - Network security and security managed services at EIS
 - Capital improvements and deferred maintenance
