# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure establishes that a violation of the provisions about home solicitation or telephone solicitation sales are unlawful practices under the Unlawful Trade Practices Act. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

- Reasons why there are barriers to Oregonians finding and using the existing case law

# **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-1 The amendment removes language that a person may bring an action under ORS 646.638.

ORS 83.710 - 83.750 are the statutes about home and telephone solicitation sales.

ORS 646.608 is the statute that Additional unlawful business, trade practices

ORS 646.638 is the statute that allows a civil action by a private party.
