**Measure Description**

The measure makes a one-time appropriation of \$600,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) in the 2025-27 biennium for distribution to the Sustainable City Year Program at the University of Oregon for the purpose of developing sustainability policy support for local communities.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$600,000 General Fund in the 2025-27 biennium. HECC will distribute this one-time General Fund appropriation as pass-through funding to the University of Oregon, which will use the funding to support the continued operation of the Sustainable City Year Program. The measure is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact in the 2027-29 biennium.

**Relevant Dates**

The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on July 1, 2025.
