CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT DEBRICK

of Lorane Route Box 572, Cottage Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pass Creek

a tributary of Umpeus River irrigation of 3.5 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29704 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purp > 3s, and shall $n \cdot exceed$ 0.0h cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 M4, Section 20, T. 21 S., R. L W., W. N. Diversion point located 680 feet South and 2380 feet East from the NM Corner, Section 20.

Section 20. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 3.5 acres NE¹/₂ NW¹/₂ Section 20 T. 21 S., R. L W., W. M.



What cannot change?

- •Source
- •Rate of diversion cannot increase
- Annual duty limited to what could have originally been used beneficially
- Priority date
- Number of irrigated acres
 - Except under Allocation of Conserved Water process
- •Season of use in most cases
