**Measure Description**

The measure makes a one-time appropriation of \$840,000 General Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) for distribution to the Oregon Coast Visitors Association to be used for a research and development project about using fish for non-food manufacturing. The measure provides direction to the Oregon Coast Visitors Association on how to spend the funds.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The fiscal impact of the measure is \$840,000 General Fund in the 2025-27 biennium. OBDD will distribute this pass-through funding to the Oregon Coast Visitors Association to undertake the proposed project. Although there will be some administrative cost to OBDD associated with developing the grant agreement and legal review, the administrative impact on OBDD is anticipated to be minimal. The measure is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact in the 2027-29 biennium.

**Relevant Dates**

The measure takes effect on January 1, 2026. Therefore, the General Fund appropriation in the measure will not be available for distribution until January 1, 2026.
