WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure directs the Department of Human Services to study developmental disabilities services and report to interim legislative committees by September 15, 2026. The measure sunsets on January 2, 2027.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 The amendment replaces the measure. The amendment requires the Department of Human Services (ODHS) to adjust for inflation the payments made to contracted provider agencies that provide services for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD).

Detailed Summary

- Defines terms.
- Requires ODHS to calculate by April 30 each year the adjustment of payments made to contracted provider agencies that provide services for individuals with IDD based on the U.S. City Average Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers.
- Requires ODHS to make adjustments to payments made to contracted provider agencies based on the above calculation.
- Specifies that adjustments to payments take effect on July 1 of each year.
