WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Education to expend \$500,000 from the Statewide Education Initiatives Account to award grants to Title I schools for educational activities during recess, lunch, or after school. It declares an emergency and takes effect July 1, 2025.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Needs of Title I elementary schools
- Educational activities for students

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act was enacted by Congress to provide extra funding for K-12 schools in low-income communities. <u>Records</u> from the <u>Oregon Department of Education</u> indicate that in the 2023-2024 school year, Oregon had nearly 600 Title I schools.
