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## Problem

Oregon is in a housing emergency. We need more single-family homes. Work is already being done to improve housing in urban and suburban Oregon, but rural Oregon is being left out.

### Solution

#### CREATING RURAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS (RHD) OUTSIDE OF CITY LIMITS AND UGBS

- Creating Rural Housing Developments (RHD) outside of city limits and UGBs
- Local control: counties decide if they want to designate land for rural housing
- 1 acre maximum lot sizes
- Cannot use urban reserves
- Productive farm or forestland cannot be developed Traditional power or solar for the development
- Shared well and sewer systems
- Gravel roads
