Bill Title: Relating to fishing; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Administrative Services, Department of Fish and Wildlife, Bonding

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture, Land Use, Natural Resources, and Water to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure authorizes the issuance of lottery revenue bonds in an amount that produces \$2 million in net proceeds for the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife for deposit into to the subaccount referred to in ORS 496.283. Funds will be used to provide grants to develop and improve fishing access sites that fall within an urban growth boundary. This measure will have a fiscal impact related to the issuance of lottery revenue bonds, including costs of issuance, debt service reserves, and Lottery Funds debt service. Lottery revenue bond authority will need to be established for project proceeds, as well as costs of issuance and debt service reserves. Estimated Lottery Funds debt service in the 2025-27 and 2027-29 biennia will depend on timing of the issuance.
