Bill Title: Relating to support for health care providers.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Consumer and Business Services, Oregon Health Authority

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Primary Care Incentive Fund which is to be used by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to fund a primary care provider loan repayment program and a primary care incentive program. OHA and the Department of Consumer and Business Services are directed to convene a nine-member task force to assist in the development and implementation of an online portal to report data on health outcome and quality measures; both agencies will staff the task force. Additionally, OHA is directed to complete a study on credentialing health care practitioners.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
