WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure amends the Oregon Consumer Privacy Act to reduce the threshold for a person doing business in Oregon who controls or processes personal data above which, they would be subject to regulation. Prohibits a controller from selling sensitive data. Prohibits controllers from processing sensitive data for the purposes of targeted advertising or profiling a consumer in furtherance of decisions that produce legal effects or effects of similar significance.
