Bill Title: Relating to services for COFA citizens; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Human Services, Oregon Health Authority

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Establishes the COFA Shared Services Office and directs the office to assist COFA citizens in applying for and accessing federal, state, or local benefits for which they are eligible. Additionally, the COFA Shared Services Office will award grants to eligible community organizations and provide incentives to increase COFA citizen recruitment and retention of traditional health workers. The office must also develop and maintain a website with available services. The measure requires the office to be under the supervision of a director and include at least one innovator agent, one community ambassador and three community outreach specialists.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
