## HB 3484 -9 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure requires the Oregon Water Resources Department to study rules related to water and to submit a report to a water-related interim committee of the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2026. Sunsets the reporting requirement January 2, 2027.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-9 The amendment replaces the measure. It Increases the General Fund appropriation for administrative services to the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) made through Enrolled Senate Bill 5543, by \$227,328 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for positions related to water right transaction processing activities. It further Increases the General Fund appropriation for water rights and adjudications to OWRD, made through Enrolled Senate Bill 5543, by \$1,464,003 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025 for positions related to water right transaction processing activities. The amendment declares an emergency and takes effect on its passage.
