Bill Title: Relating to animals; declaring an emergency.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Wildfire to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes licensing fees for animal rescue entities and breeders and directs the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) to adopt rules for compliance, inspections, and care standards for animal rescue entities and breeders. The measure allows civil and criminal penalties for violations. An unspecified General Fund appropriation is provided to ODA in the 2025-27 biennium to support implementation, education, and outreach.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
