**Bill Title:** Relating to the application of a prevailing rate of wage to off-site custom work for use in public works; prescribing an effective date.

## Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Labor and Workplace Standards to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure applies prevailing wage requirements to bespoke, off-site fabrication, preconstruction, assembly, or construction work performed specifically for projects on certain systems. These requirements may impact future projects planned by state agencies, local governments, special districts and school districts. These requirements apply to solicited contracts and public contracts on or after July 1, 2026.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
