The revenue impact of this measure is indeterminate for the following reasons:

Although the bill directs one half of all future restitution payments from criminal cases to insurance carriers be directed to Department of Justice (DOJ), the bill also provides the option for insurance carriers to seek damage recovery through civil cases instead of criminal cases. In those instances, restitution would not be collected through the court and no payments would be sent to DOJ.

Restitution that will be ordered to insurance carriers in criminal cases (1/2 of it to DOJ) might be positive state revenue, however, the extent to which those insurance carriers may instead seek reimbursement through civil cases might make the revenue yield to the state be limited.
