Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Emergency Management, General Government, and Veterans to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Energy, in collaboration with the Department of Environmental Quality, the Department of Land Conservation and Development, and the Labor Education and Research Center at the University of Oregon, to develop the Statewide Geographic Diversity of Fueling Stations for Disaster Reserves Priority Action Plan.
