Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Emergency Management, General Government, and Veterans to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the purpose of generating proceeds for funding of grants to local governments and entities for Statewide Preparedness Authority for Response Coordination.
