Bill Title: Relating to food served under the Child and Adult Care Food Program; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Early Learning and Care, Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, School Districts

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Child and Adult Care Food Program Supplemental Fund, which is continuously appropriated to the Oregon Department of Education to implement policies and procedures that increase the access to health and culturally-relevant foods for children in child care. The measure appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Oregon State University Extension Service to create culturally-specific menus for food based on nutritional guidelines for the Child and Adult Care Food Program.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
