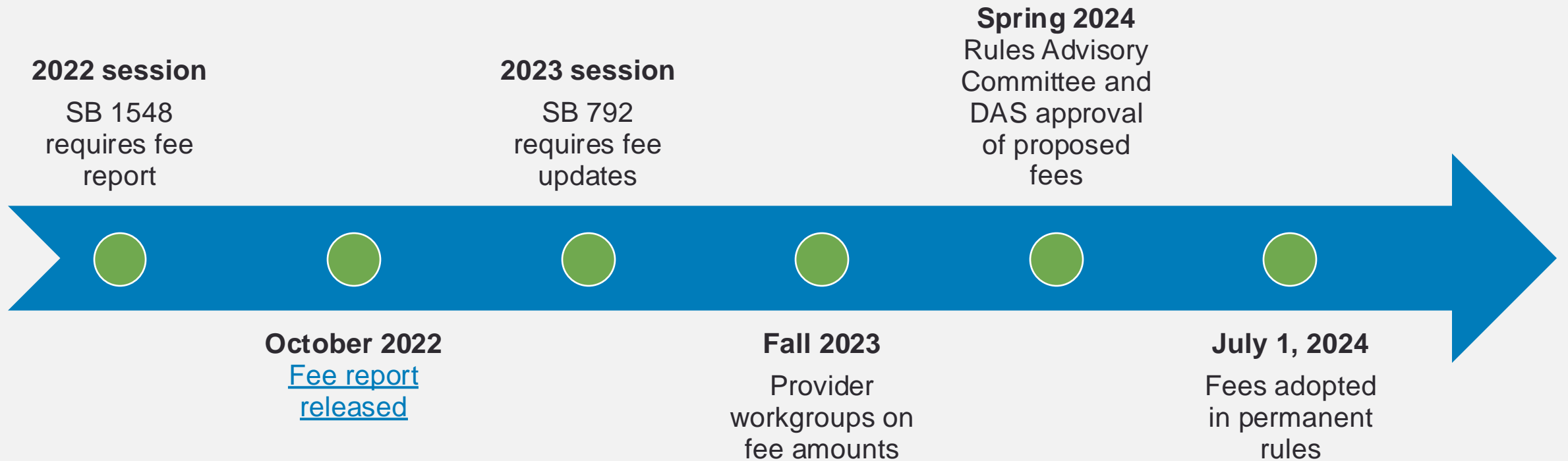


Senate Bill 5527

- Ratifies fee increases for ODDS-licensed provider applications and renewals
- Already approved by Department of Administrative Services (DAS)
- Fulfills requirements of Senate Bill 792

Fee changes: Foster care providers

Adult foster home: Multnomah, Clackamas, and Washington counties	\$50/person	\$75/person	\$0	\$50/person	Quality Care Fund
Adult foster home: All other counties	\$50/person	\$50/person	\$0	\$50/person	
Adult foster home: Resident manager change fee	\$10	\$0	NA	NA	

Fees collected since July 1, 2024

Fee type	Estimated revenue
Agency certification applications	\$311,000
Endorsement applications	\$4,000
24-hour residential licenses	\$242,575
Host Homes licenses	\$650
Adult foster home licenses	\$98,450

Total: \$656,675
