Bill Title: Relating to health care.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Consumer and Business Services, Oregon Health Authority

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires health insurance carriers in Oregon who reimburse primary care services, to reimburse primary care providers at independent practices at the same relative unit and conversion factor as providers who practice within a hospital-based or affiliated health system. The measure directs the Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt the American Medical Association's Current Procedural Terminology codes for primary care services and the annual benchmark reimbursement rate based on the hospital rates published in the Hospital Price Transparency Final Rule.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
