BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) maintains a number of different divisions to regulate issues such as drivers and motor vehicles, commercial vehicle transportation, and public transportation, among others. The agency has undergone restructuring of its regulatory framework and structure over the years; for example, in the past, ODOT operated with separate divisions for rail transportation and for public transit; today, the two are combined under the Public Transportation Division, with rail being a section within that division.
