## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the 23-member Task Force on Prioritized List of Health Services which is to study the potential impact of phasing out the prioritized list produced by the Health Evidence Review Commission for the for specific scenarios. The Legislative Policy and Research Office and the Oregon Health Authority will jointly staff the committee.
