Bill Title: Relating to adult residential mental health services; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Task Force/Committee/Workgroup

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to convene a work group to study adult residential mental health services provided to medical assistance recipients enrolled in coordinated care organizations (CCOs) in certain facilities, and the feasibility of transferring the financial risk and administration of those services from OHA to CCOs.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
