Bill Title: Relating to courts.

Government Unit(s) Affected: District Attorneys, Cities, Judicial Department, Department of Corrections, Department of State Police

Summary of Fiscal Impact

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - see explanatory analysis.

Measure Description

The measure makes eligible an individual who has had a classification of a conviction reduced by the court to petition a set aside of that conviction based on the time period associated with the reduced offense and specifies that the change does not apply to the dismissal of traffic violation citations. The provisions apply to motions filed on or after the effective date of the measure.

Fiscal Analysis

The fiscal impact to the Department of Correction (DOC) is indeterminate. The measure may increase the number of set aside cases that the Department will need to process immediately that would have been processed at a later time. However, the number of cases that will need to be immediately set aside due to the measure is not able to be determined at this time nor how long the sudden increase will last.

There is a minimal fiscal impact to the Oregon Judicial Department and no fiscal impact to the District Attorneys, Department of State Police, or cities.
