**Bill Title:** Relating to respite care; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Human Services, Oregon Health Authority

## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires respite care be provided through the state medical assistance program to caregivers of children or youth and youth who are at least 14 years of age. The Oregon Health Authority is directed to support the development and maintenance of respite care services using any available funding source.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
