Bill Title: Relating to land use; declaring an emergency.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Housing and Homelessness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure expands where middle housing must be permitted and revises related definitions and approval procedures. The measure broadens applicability to include urban unincorporated areas, allows increased unit counts for affordable or accessible housing, and updates timelines and requirements for land use reviews and approvals. The measure is anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Department of Land Conservation and Development related to rulemaking and providing technical assistance to local governments.
