Bill Title: Relating to the Children's Advocate; prescribing an effective date.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure moves the Children's Advocate from the Department of Human Services to the Long-Term Care Ombudsman. Additionally, the measure establishes the Children's Advocate Account and an independent 15-member Children's Advocacy Advisory Board.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
