# Composition<sup>3</sup>

The board consist of 11 members, including:

- one residential structures construction contractor (FRY);
- one residential structures remodeling contractor (RIDDLE);
- one contractor specializing in building multifamily housing three stories or less above grade (SAWYERS);
- one home designer or architect (KELSO);
- one building official (BLAIRE);
- one residential building trade subcontractor (VACANT);
- one structural engineer (WONG);
- one representative of a utility or energy supplier (LUTTER);
- one manufactured dwellings manufacturer (AUSTIN);
- one new manufactured dwellings seller or distributor (ZECHENELLY); and
- one public member who does not receive compensation from any interest represented on the board (KEMPER).

Members serve four-year terms, limited to two full terms. The Governor may remove a member for good cause, including three unexcused absences during any 12-month period. The board must meet at least twice per year.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The board helps the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) administer the Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Program and Small Home Specialty Code. The board must

- find that the added cost, if any, of any proposed rules, is necessary to the health and safety of the occupants or the public, or to conserve scarce resources;
- review and report recommendations and adoption of amendments to the Residential Specialty Code, Small Home Specialty Code, Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code, and Manufactured Dwelling and Parks Specialty Code:
- approve technical and scientific facts related to construction material, design, or method;
- approve alternative regulatory options for emerging technologies;
- receive and adjudicate appeals of suspected code violations, building official decisions, and municipal appeals board decisions;
- adopt rules the director considers necessary to interpret, harmonize, streamline, adjust, promote consistency within, reduce confusion regarding, administer, or enforce the state building code;
- adopt design and construction standards for mitigating radon levels in new residential buildings;
- adopt standards for determining whether the installation of a single electrical meter for all dwelling units in a multifamily residential building facilitates an overall reduction in electrical consumption by such units;
- select two members to serve on the Construction Industry Energy Board;
- consult with the director on alternative permit and inspection programs on the adoption of uniform energy conservation standards and the Reach Code; and
- advise the director on standards, qualifications, and training for building officials and inspectors.
