### **STATE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the State Parks and Recreation Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New Appointees**

Dave Parulo of Beaverton Stu Spence of La Grande

#### Terms

June 1, 2025 - May 31, 2029

#### **Statutory Authority**

ORS 390.114 (2023).

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

#### **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The commission has seven members, including at least one from each congressional district (**PARULO (CD1)**, **SPENCE (CD2)**, IZUMI (CD3), CRIBBINS (CD4), HILL (CD4), CONDER (CD5), BERGER (CD6)). Of those members, one must reside west of the summit of the Coast Mountain Range (**PARULO**) and one must resides east of the summit of the Cascade Mountain Range (**SPENCE**).

When appointing members, the Governor must consider outdoor and heritage interest, as well as racial, ethnic, gender and geographic diversity. Members serve four-year terms. The Governor designates a chair. The commission meets once every three months.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The commission promotes outdoor recreation and establishes policies for the operation of the State Parks and Recreation Department.

The commission must

- appoint and guide a State Parks and Recreation director;
- authorize the use of specified funds, gifts, and donations;
- make recommendations regarding administration of the Office of Outdoor Recreation;
- consult with its director on the appointment of an associate director;
- conduct rulemaking in consultation with the Mark O. Hatfield School of Government and the governing bodies of federally recognized tribes within Oregon's borders, to establish procedures to resolve disputes concerning archaeological sites and historical materials; and
- appoint members to and consult with the All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Commission and the Oregon Recreational Trails Advisory Council.
