The Behavioral Health Provider Directory is a fully integrated system established to help all Oregonians seeking treatment services to get timely access.


The Behavioral Health Provider Directory currently provide CCO information, ENCC information, host the Mental Health Residential Capacity Report and the Adult SUD Residential Capacity Report.

Who can use the Behavioral Health Provider Directory?

- An easily accessible public website for individuals to find a treatment provider to meet their need
- Clinicians can work together with clients to find providers who understand and affirm their identities and are accessible based on location.
- Exceptional Needs Care Coordinators (ENCC) and other Professional Case Managers can access the residential capacity reports to refer clients accordingly.



State of Oregon Bed Capacity





State of Oregon Bed Capacity



- Ongoing working relationship with OHA and OCBH representatives


