#### Private Professional Certification and Licensing Program

This program includes three fee-based regulatory programs.

- Private Security Provider Certification and Licensure: 26,000 individuals who are certified or licensed to perform private security services
- Private Security Entity Licensure: 450 businesses or entities that employ private security providers and are licensed to provide private security services
- Private Investigator Licensure: 800 individuals

- > Private security provider certifications and licenses are issued for a 2-year period.
- ➤ The last fee increase for the program was effective November 1, 2022.
- ➤ Key drivers for the provider fee increases included the pay equity salary increases in 2024 and legal expenses for DOJ services.

### **Private Security Entity Fees**

	Prior Fee	Fee Effective February 1, 2025
Private Security Entity	\$624	\$936

- ➤ Private security entity licenses are issued for one year, July 1 through June 30.
- ➤ Private security entity licensing began January 1, 2024. HB 2527 (2021)
- ➤ This fee is most significantly affected by the total number of applicants.



#### Private Investigator Fees

	Prior Fee	Fee Effective February 1, 2025
Investigator License	\$550	\$690
Late Renewal Fee	\$30	\$35

- ➤ Investigator licenses are issued for a 2-year period.
- ➤ The late fee and replacement fee were last increased effective November 1, 2022.
- > The \$550 license fee had been the same since 2006.
- ➤ Key drivers for the investigator license fee increase included the pay equity salary increases in 2024, legal expenses for DOJ services, and overall cost increases over time.
