Measure Description:

Specifies that the County Fair Account receives an amount equal to nine-tenths of one percent of the Oregon Lottery net proceeds. Takes effect on passage.

Impact Explanation:

According to the March 2025 Oregon Economic and Revenue Forecast, lottery net proceeds are \$1,922.0 million in the 2025-27 biennium, \$2,072.0 million in the 2027-29 biennium, and \$2,228.6 million in the 2029-31 biennium. Under this measure, nine-tenths of one percent of these net proceeds will be distributions to the County Fair Account. The increase in distributions to the account under this measure will leave the legislature with less lottery net proceeds available for other discretionary allocations.
