WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure authorizes the City of Monmouth to modify its urban growth boundary by adding or removing sites through a specified process. It requires the City to adopt changes to its comprehensive plan and land use regulations to ensure residential development at a minimum density of seven units per acre on added sites. Sunsets January 2, 2033.

Revenue impact: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.
