

## **SB 49 A STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

#### **WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

The measure increases membership of the Building Codes Structures Board from nine to eleven members and specifies membership requirements.

*Fiscal impact: Has minimal fiscal impact*

*Revenue impact: No revenue impact*

*SENATE VOTE: Ayes, 27; Nays, 1; Excused, 2.*

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Building Codes Structures Board is a nine-member, governor-appointed board (subject to Senate confirmation) established in ORS 455.132 to advise and assist the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services in administering Oregon's structural, prefabricated structures, energy conservation, and accessibility for persons with physical disabilities programs; it reviews and recommends changes to the structural specialty code, holds public meetings for testimony, and supports rulemaking under the State Building Code.
