Aged Cases Action Plan

POSITIONS

- New Interim Chief Investigator
- Five temp staff covering investigative and administrative duties
- Hiring for vacant permanent position

PROCESS

- All aged cases assigned to a team with a lead
- Regular meetings with ODHS, DAS, and OSP on suspended cases
- All new cases screened promptly and assigned by Chief Investigator

TRACKING

- Renewed efforts to move to an updated database
- Weekly reporting to agency executive team and partners



Internal Controls

Regular Control Meetings

- PSO/Director's Office: Daily
- PSO/HR: Weekly
- Director's Office/Governor's Office: Bi-Weekly
- PSO/Governor's Office: Quarterly
- PSO/OSP/DA: Monthly

Staff Management and Oversight

- Completed staff training and retraining
- Reset clear expectations regarding investigations, fidelity to policies, time in the office, and time in facilities and field offices
- Implemented individual coaching and, as necessary, performance plans

PREA Review of PSO Cases

Our PREA coordinator operates <u>independently</u> of our Professional Standards Office.

Potential PREA concerns are processed simultaneously & separately as PSO <u>cases</u> and PREA <u>reviews</u>.

To fulfill the federal requirements, PREA reviews may take longer to close.











OYA has a zero-tolerance standard for abuse or harassment.

PREA reviews are triggered by anything from verbal harassment to physical sexual assault.

Staff are **required** to report **any knowledge**, **suspicion**, **or youth reports** of abuse or harassment.



Reporting

Youth and community can **report** via:

- OYA reporting line
- Governor's Constituent Services office
- Filing a grievance
- Speaking with any OYA staff
- Reporting form on OYA's website (community only)
