Subject: SB 5544 – Relating to state financial administration

Work Session Recommendations

SB 5544 is a fee ratification bill for the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE). During the 2023-25 biennium, OBCE established new and increased fees through the administrative rulemaking process, which were approved by the Department of Administrative Services. The measure, as amended by the -1 amendment, legislatively ratifies these new and increased fees. Under ORS 291.055(1)(e), all new agency fees or fee increases adopted between the date of adjournment sine die of a regular legislative session and the date of adjournment sine die of the next regular legislative session, unless the fee is authorized by enabling legislation.

Several sections in ORS Chapter 684 establish OBCE's authority to impose and collect various fees related to licensing and regulation of chiropractic physicians and chiropractic assistants. OBCE's 2023-25 legislatively adopted budget included a 20% fee increase to all license types. Since then, OBCE has adopted a 30% fee increase and established or increased various fees through the administrative rulemaking process. To remain in effect, the following fees must be ratified by the Legislature before adjournment of the 2025 session:

These new and increased fees are projected to generate an additional \$636,898 in Other Funds revenue, which will sustain agency operations through the 2025-27 biennium. However, without an overall increase in licensees, the Board will likely need another fee increase in the 2027-29 biennium.
