Notice of Oregon Criminal Record Check

This notice is to inform you that the Oregon Department of Human Services Child Welfare Office may complete an Oregon criminal record check on you. The information would be used by a caseworker in assessing the safety needs of children.

You have a right to a copy of your criminal record and to challenge the information in your criminal record through the Oregon State Police procedures outlined in ORS 0181.555(3) and OAR 257-010-0035. In some circumstances, you may have to pay a fee to get a copy of your criminal record.



You may have rights under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Discrimination by an employer on the basis of arrests alone may violate federal law. Individuals wishing to obtain information regarding civil rights should contact the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries or the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.
