Chair Manning, Jr, Vice Chair Thatcher and members of the Committees:

Thank you for allowing me to speak today.

"So long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them."

The Elks National Veterans Service Commission takes that pledge one step further and promises service to our nation's veterans and military members, with a special focus on service to those in need

Thousands of Elks volunteers give generously of their time, energy and resources to serve veterans and military members each day to ensure that pledge is not an idle one. Today, volunteers provide direct service to veterans and military members in their communities providing them with services where they live. We help veterans rehabilitate and thrive through adaptive sports programs, therapy kits and our Welcome Home initiative reaching out to some of our most vulnerable veterans, those who are experiencing homelessness.

To that end, Elks in Oregon volunteer their time and money to the 11 hospitals, the PAWS project and the project called Cross the Divide.

In our funding, a small contingency is set aside for any additional support that is needed. \$91,285 was spent this last year. You will see in the attached paperwork, Boise VA Hospital. We provide money to that hospital because on the east side of our state, Veterans are closer to Boise than coming to Portland. A few years ago, our state association purchased a couple of new vans so the veterans on the east side could be transported to the Boise hospital.

Welcome Home Kits, a new program that was developed, helps veterans who are experiencing homelessness get off the streets and into their own homes. Although, most of the time a small quarters, but Elks volunteers furnish those quarters with some of the things it takes to set up a house (list attached). Veterans are furnished with microwaves, pots and pans, dishes, cleaning supplies, sheets, pillowcases, comforters, alarm clocks, blenders etc. All these supplies are new, which are paid for by Elk's member donations.

We have provided 182 kits and are currently working on many more to the tune of \$12,630 so far.

Some of the other events Elks do across the state are stand downs, Adopt a Vet program, Veterans lunches, benefit dinners, outings, visits to the hospitals, fishing trips, and a great Veteran's Day program. Each lodge across the state does this and some even do parades. All Elks on Friday wear a red shirt. This is in honor of those currently serving. RED Remember Everyone Deployed. Our Elks way of honoring them.

In the past, I personally worked with the local VSO to get medals for the WWII and Korean veterans that came home missing their medals. One of those Veteran's had earned a Silver Star. He got his medal.

There are about 23,000 Elks across this state and we have 48 active lodges. Elks do not get paid. We are volunteers and a charitable fraternal organization. We have other committees including Scholarships for local students, Drug Awareness that considers the lower grades in schools, Hoop Shoot which is a free throw contest for children 8-13 years old, the Meadowood Speech and Hearing camps for children with these issues. These children go to camp each year where they work with clinicians that help them and our Oregon Elks Children's Eye Clinic at OHSU. This clinic has been in existence since the 1940's and Elks contributed over \$75,000,000 in this state of the art, and world-renowned facility known for its research and eye care for our youth.

Through our volunteer work, our hours and miles that are reported Elks across Oregon have donated over \$13,000,000 in our charitable work this past lodge year. Report included.

Finally, in our states lodges we have approximately 3,000 members that are veterans.

Thank you so much for this opportunity to speak to you today.
