The Commission on Judicial Fitness and Disability (CJFD) investigates and acts upon complaints of judicial misconduct or disability. The Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) recommendation for HB 5013 and the 2025-27 biennium is to fund the Commission at \$642,144 General Fund and one permanent full-time position (1.00 FTE). Funding in the amount of \$23,324 is included for extraordinary expenses.

The LFO recommendation is \$215,484, or 50.5%, more than the 2023-25 legislatively approved budget and \$248,505, or 63.1%, more than the 2025-27 current service level budget. The following investment is included in the budget:

• \$248,505 General for Policy Package #100 to increase the Executive Director from a permanent part-time to a permanent full-time position (0.50 FTE).

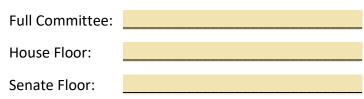
