Subject:	HB 2805 – Relating to food establishment licenses Work Session Recommendations

The measure removes the sunset date on an annual 3% increase for food establishment licenses the Oregon Department of Agriculture is authorized to charge under ORS 616.341. Additionally, the measure authorizes the agency to adopt fees by rule and increase fees by no more than 3% annually, rounded to the next higher whole dollar amount.

The Department's appropriation bill, SB 5502, assumes passage of HB 2805 and includes \$140,152 in estimated Other Funds revenue for the 2025-27 biennium.
