Subject: HB 2342 – Relating to fees concerning wildlife

**Work Session Recommendations** 

The measure increases various recreational and commercial hunting and angling licenses, permit, and tag fees over the course of six years, with the first effective increase January 1, 2026, then January 1, 2028, and finally January 1, 2030.

Additionally, the measure establishes the Marine Fisheries Enhancement Fund subaccount that is continuously appropriated to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to promote and enhance marine fisheries and marine conservation. The dedicated revenue source for the Fund is an ocean endorsement that is estimated to generate \$890,000 during the 2025-27 biennium.

The Department's appropriation bill, HB 5009, assumes passage of HB 2342 and includes \$18.1 million in estimated Other Funds revenue for the 2025-27 biennium.

## **Final Subcommittee Action**
