Subject:	HB 2208 – Relating to community health improvement plans Work Session Recommendations

Currently, Coordinated Care Organizations (CCOs) are required to collaborate with local public health authorities and hospitals when conducting a community health assessment and adopting community health improvement plans. The measure broadens that collaboration by including community mental health programs and local planning committees related to alcohol and drug prevention and treatment services. It also requires CCOs, local public health authorities, and community mental health programs to incorporate their behavioral health plans into the community mental health improvement plan. To support these changes, the Oregon Health Authority must adopt rules to align these new requirements with existing planning and reporting obligations. The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority and no fiscal impact on counties.
