Bill Title: Relating to state agency relations with nonprofit organizations; prescribing an effective date.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Nonprofit Organization Advisory Council and requires the Council to review grant and procurement processes for agencies who contract with nonprofit entities. For contracted nonprofit services provided under a declared emergency, the measure requires agencies to offer advance payment at a minimum of 25% of the price for contracted nonprofit services over a 12-month term. The measure allows nonprofit organizations to charge a negotiated indirect cost rate.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
